Restricted Gas Licence in detail:

Course outline:

The restricted gas course is made of selected units from CPC32713 Certificate III in Gas Fitting. It is designed to enable participants to service Type A domestic and commercial appliances, by applying for their Queensland Gas Work Licence Restricted to Service. It can also be used as pathway to completing the Certificate III in Gas Fitting. For NSW, there is no gas service licence, this course is used to enable competence and a qualification for gas work restricted to service. It is recommended the successful participant apply for a Queensland Gas Work Licence - Restricted to Service, as further evidence of competency.

Delivery mode:

In class for 9 days over a period, starting with a pre-course eLearning to be completed prior to attending practical training.

Who can do Restricted Gas Licence? (Queensland)

The course is open to anyone looking to gain further knowledge in servicing Type A appliances. This includes (but is not only for) licensed tradespersons within the electrical, mechanical, electronics, metal work, refrigeration and air-conditioning fields who are required to work on Type A gas appliances.



How long will I hold this licence for? (Queensland)

In the first issue of Gas Work Licence - Restricted to Service will be limited to 3 years, then after that applicants can apply for a 6-year Restricted Gas Licence. The Gas Work Restricted to Service licence is valid for if you to maintain currency and renew by the due date, however it must be renewed every 6 years which incurs a small fee each time. It is recommended to keep an experience log and carry out refresher training each year.

Course details:

Attendees will gain valuable knowledge about correct and safe working procedures for Type A commercial/domestic gas appliances, gas and electrical servicing, general safety and risk control processes, commissioning, repairs, program service and maintenance from the basics, to correct servicing techniques of more complex equipment and how to safety check and leak check equipment, plus many other benefits.

The course will have a mixture of practical and theoretical training on a wide range of commercial gas equipment. The course has been designed as an **interactive training system** to comply with the National Training System, from the Construction, Plumbing and Services Integrated Framework Training Package and delivered by qualified and industry current educators. How to get a USI Number

Steps to create a USI Number

Step 1. Have at least one and preferably two forms of ID ready from the list below:

- Driver's Licence
- Medicare Card
- Australian Passport
- Visa (with Non-Australian Passport) for international students
- Certificate of Registration by Descent
- Citizenship Certificate
- Immi Card

Step 2. Have contact details ready (e.g. email address, or mobile number, or address).

Step 3. Visit the USI website at: usi.gov.au

Step 4. Select the 'Create a USI' link and follow the steps.

Step 5. Agree to the Terms and Conditions.

Step 6. Follow the instructions to create a USI – it should only take a few minutes. Upon completion, the USI will be displayed on the screen. It will also be sent to the student's preferred method contact.

Step 7. The student should then write down the USI and keep it somewhere handy and safe.

Important Make sure your personal details entered when creating your USI must match exactly with those on their form of ID.

Frequently Asked Questions- Additional Information

Caravan Servicing and Certification Licence restrictions.

Upon completion of the Gas Work Licence Restricted to Service with Caravan option successful students will be able to issue Gas System Compliance Certificates to meet the relevant inspection/certification requirements. Gas System Compliance Certificates may only be issued for caravan, RV's and motorhomes, and boats/marine do not fall under this unit.

Please note: This unit does not allow students to certify individual gas appliances, however only review gas system compliance as a whole, which is necessary for completion prior to issuing road worthy certificates. No individual appliance gas certification work may be completed under this licence.

- Gas System Compliance Certification must consider all relevant safety requirements of caravans with particular emphasis on ensuring appliances are approved, adequate ventilation, good combustion and no leakage. The certificate you sign states that you have inspected the gas system and that all the requirements of the standard have been met.

Work outside the scope of your licence (Gas Work Licence – Restricted to Service with Caravan unit):

- You are not permitted to install a new or replacement gas appliance of any type including 'like for like'. However, you may 'refit' the same appliance which you removed for cleaning/checking, but only in the same place and in the same way.
- You are not permitted to carry out any installation, modification or repair to pipework other than tightening existing joints to seal any leakage.
- You are not permitted to accept/certify any work that is not in strict compliance with the standards

Can I install Type A appliances?

No. You must undertake your Full Gas Licence (Certificate III in Gas Fitting) to be able to install gas appliances. Under the Restricted Gas Licence you are only able to service domestic and commercial gas appliances ,Type A gas appliances only.

What is a Gas Work Licence restricted to service?

The gas Service licence allows the competent person to carry our service maintenance and repairs of Type A gas appliances, like gas stoves, gas hot water systems, gas commercial catering equipment and many other appliances. The gas service licence allows you to disconnect and reconnect the existing Type A gas appliance. You are able to issue a gas defect notice if required.

Can you service Type B industrial gas appliances? No! This requires further experience and the completion of CPCPGS4023B Install, service maintain Type B gas appliances and complete a restricted electrical licence or have an REL.
